A heartfelt thank you to our incredible trapping and rescue team for their unwavering dedication.

Charlotte Spencer, our trapping specialist, leads the way in managing feed stations and remote relocation trapping. Together with Hayley, Terry, Jacquie, Kristina and Kelly, no matter the conditions—pouring rain, freezing cold, or the dead of night—they never give up. Last year, this dedicated team rescued 16 cats abandoned in remote wilderness areas, giving them a second chance at life. So far this year, they have already saved 11 more.

Emily Beckham heads our rescue team, tirelessly working to bring in lost, abandoned, and colony cats. In 2024, she rescued 45 cats, most of them vulnerable kittens. This year, she has already saved 43 more, ensuring they receive the care they need. Of those, 35 are kittens!

Their work often happens behind the scenes, unnoticed by many, but it is vital and incredibly difficult. They spend long hours outdoors in all kinds of weather, driven by their love for these cats and their commitment to saving lives.

We are deeply grateful to Charlotte and Emily and the entire team for their passion, perseverance, and the countless cats they have rescued. Their efforts make all the difference.
